Dun Gifford is president of Oldways Preservation Trust, which he founded in 1990 in Boston to promote healthy eating and drinking, to encourage traditional and sustainable food choices and to develop effective programs for helping consumers change their food choice behaviors.

Gifford graduated from Harvard College and Harvard Law School, served in the U.S. Navy, and was also legislative assistant to Senator Edward F. Kennedy, as well as a national campaign coordinator for Senator Robert F. Kennedy. List of positions include: officer of Cabot, Cabot & Forbes; chairman of Common Cause/Massachusetts; chairman of the American Institute of Wine & Food; and chairman of the Nantucket Electric Company. He has owned and managed a number of restaurants in Boston and Cambridge, and founded a food business (Kilvert & Forbes) with John Kerry, now a U.S. Senator. Gifford is the co-author, along with Oldways executive vice president, of *The Oldways Table: Essays and Recipes from the Culinary Think Tank*.
